Currently, he runs a basic science research laboratory focused on alopecia areata (AA), supervises the resident-staffed Hair Disorders Clinic, serves as site Principal Investigator for AA clinical trials, and oversees the University of Iowa AA Registry. Dr. Jabbari has received funding from a variety of sources including the National Institutes of Health, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and the Dermatology Foundation.
